**Phone line Volunteer Conduct-** John R. spoke As a member of Narcotics Anonymous you do indeed have MANY rights, such as; You may introduce yourself as 'An Addict' or An Addict and a Alcoholic' or pretty much any manner you choose. You may attend Only NA Meetings or NA as well as any other recovery meetings you choose. You may tell others how attendance at other fellowships has worked for you and even encourage them to attend also. These rights (as well as many others) are allowed for each

NA member to exercise as they see fit without fear of judgment or reprisal. **BUT** (yes there is usually one somewhere)

When a NA member decides they are going to participate in NA Service via the Phone Line there are some restrictions on these rights that they freely relinquish, such as;

A Phone line volunteer **MUST NEVER CONDEMN NOR RECOMMEND OTHER FELLOWSHIPS, PERIOD.**

If relinquishing these rights is a problem for a member during the training they are not placed on the Phone Line Volunteer List. If a Volunteer is found to not be adhering to the restrictions as stated they will be removed from the list. This may seem odd or dictatorial to some but it is simply a direct application of the NA Traditions and the guidelines of our Service Structure that those who came before us put together. August 2011

Hello Family. Our event has passed. Pre event ticket sales were incredible. Attendance to the event was very less than expected for whatever reason. On the other hand, the participation we received from those that were there was very exciting. We are very pleased that we have done our job to the best of our ability. Our purpose was to promote unity, discuss solutions, & get your input on how to improve our Area Service Committee functions. We have effectively exposed some problems of our Area and more importantly some possible solutions & if developed can start a movement in a direction to handle the issues our area has been experiencing.

The only expense our area had to incur was \$25.00 which was paid to the church for rent during the event. You can see all transactions from this committee in the attached treasurer's report. As a result of this event we are able to donate money to support our Area.

Below you will find the TOP 3 problem areas compiled from the surveys a couple months ago, followed by a list of small group consciences in regards to these problems.

We have put solutions into 2 categories. The first is what can be done at ASC, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> is what can be done at the group level.

### **PROBLEM AREA #1- TRAINING AND SUPPORT**

#### Possible Solutions for ASC

- Informational Pamphlet (IP) explaining service positions. Localized for our area
- Annual GSR Assembly (Possibly mandatory attendance only once a year)
- ASC Training Subcommittee-for all ASC positions. To provide learning/training days & variety of other duties to be determined
- Service Appreciation
- If you nominate someone, help train them
- Only 1 year commitments
- Easier to read guidelines
- Written qualifications & references plus a list of those who trained you.

#### Possible Solutions for Groups:

- Have Topic of Traditions at your meeting
- Home Group Training and form your own home group guidelines/policy
- Encourage the position of ALT. GSR in your group
- If you nominate someone, help train them
- Established members encourage newcomers to be of service
- Service appreciation
- Have business meeting & encourage commitment to attend

### **PROBLEM AREA #2-SENSE OF UNITY**

#### Possible Solutions for ASC:

- ASC Trusted Servants visit groups to explain the workings of the ASC. To give knowledge & get group support.
- ASC Trusted Servants go to different groups and give personal invite to attend ASC.
- Sponsor activities/functions with multiple home groups
- Explain principles before personalities right before ASC
- Training day to help GSR's know what to bring back to groups

#### Possible solutions for Groups

- Sponsor activities/functions with multiple home groups
- Go to different groups branch out
- Encourage members to visit ASC meetings

### **PROBLEM AREA #3 Willingness to volunteer for service**

#### Possible Solutions for ASC:

- Sponsor guided encouragement
- Area “Fun Night” to celebrate service members
- Show appreciation to trusted servants
- Area Outreach (via forming a committee or on your own)
- Special invite to ASC to those interested in service
- Traveling home group award for bringing most newcomers
- Attraction rather than promotion
- Lower clean-time requirements for service positions not dealing with money
- Forcefully
- Strongly suggest service
- Challenge members to find willingness

#### Possible Solutions for Groups

- Lower clean-time requirements to serve in a position that does not handle money
- Show appreciation to trusted servants (positive reinforcement & encouragement)
- Strongly suggest service
- Special invite to attend home group or ASC business meetings
- Sponsor guided encouragement
- Forcefully
- Attraction rather than promotion
- Challenge members to find willingness

Now is the time for ALL MEMBERS to take a look at this to discuss & decide individually or as a group on which ones if any will be considered, made into motions then voted on & implemented into policy or the guidelines. Remember that ANYONE can make a motion. Only thing that is required is that it be seconded by a GSR. You don't even have to wait for the ASC meeting to put forth a motion. Just pick up a motion slip today & take it with you to have ready for next time. Please take the time to read through these again and follow it up with some of your own discussion. This will be all for nothing if we don't take action and do something.

Please take these back to your groups. Inform your groups of these solutions to expand on them and bring an idea either to open floor for discussion or in the form of a motion and submit to the ASC. We have enough copies for all GSR's and can get more for anyone else if need be. You can have a regular meeting, business meeting, or even a special meeting to talk more about these issues or solutions. You as GSR's are only the messengers. Your home group members don't have a clue what goes on at the area level unless you tell them.

I for one want to thank this Area for the opportunity to be of service in yet another way. I have learned a lot and hope that I can share that experience with someone else in the future. Please remove us from the committee's present roll call sheet, because this committee has been disbanded and released to pursue other things.
