Based on the discussion and assessment by the Subcommittee it was decided that beginning immediately, SENANA ASC will no longer require the Nebraska RSC to provide us with Regional Meeting Lists. The printing of them will be done by and under the SENANA PI Subcommittee responsibility and budget.

There is reason to believe that the Saturday Night Special meeting is not being held anymore. This information was provided to the PI Subcommittee via an employee of the facility that was providing space. The words of the person informing us and the attitude of other employees of the facility bring cause for concern about the starting/maintaining of that meeting. There is a prevalent opinion among those persons that it is "Their meeting" i.e. the facility was conducting it.

This attitude CANNOT support nor condoned as it is in direct conflict with many aspects of our traditions. The meeting was started without a very large 'core group' of NA Members at the behest of the facility where it was held. From past experience this is hardly ever a good reason in and of itself to start a meeting. The climate of the meeting during its life was also many times one of the vast majority of attendees being current treatment clients and with facility supervisors being in attendance. These are also aspects that have shown to be potentially negative and harmful to the health of a meeting. As we watch yet another meeting go away we should all reflect on the How, What and Why it continues to happen.
