And other members said that we need to remember to reach out to members through attraction not promotion. Workshops at the Region level have shown that we need to have lots of jobs at our home groups to promote service work. Like coffee maker or someone who puts away chairs. At this point open floor was out of time and Calvin made motion to extend second by jenny.

Question from policy Committee to ASC

How do you read page3 #5 and #6 in guidelines. Where it says #5" To later change, repeal or add to the ASC Guidelines requires a 2/3 majority vote of all voting GSR's/Proxy's." #6 say's "All other votes require a simple majority of all voting GSR's/Proxy's"

This question was asked because people were wanting an understanding if it was GSR's present at the ASC or all GSR's In the AREA.
