Also projected rate increases in both the Windstream and AT&T Communications providers did not happen.

Also ‘donations’ were made in some areas that we would have had to otherwise pay for items.

Our 2013 budget is \$158.17 less than our 2012 amount. There are funds that were not spent in 2012 that we

expect to use in either expanded or newly discovered areas during the 2013 year. The primary areas of this increase are; Professional Outreach and PSA & Training. The subcommittee has discovered several needs for presentations to Professionals as well as attendance at seminars and/or workshops that require this increase.

The PSA & Training increase is due to providing more training & awareness events as well as there being more attendees at them. We also have hopes to repaint our current PSA at 2729 N 12th ST.
